WHAT: Support for an undergraduate who wishes to take part in a project not necessarily related to their subject

WHEN: 3rd week HT

WHO: Undergraduates doing a worthwhile summer project (including travelling)

HOW MUCH: £100 - £500

EXHIBITIONS AND SCHOLARSHIPS

WHAT: Exhibitions and scholarships are awarded on an academic basis, typically for good performance in Prelims, Mods or Finals. They allow you to wear the Scholar's Gown :O

WHO: people who exhibit academic merit

HOW MUCH: £150 - £300

COLLEGE LOAN

WHAT: The college can be used to request a small sum of money as a loan, which can be repaid via battels or normal means.

WHEN: Any time

WHO: Anyone

HOW MUCH: Dependent on circumstances

UNEXPECTED HARDSHIP FUND

WHAT: A fund reserved for those who require a sum of money unexpectedly.
